Safety & Health

You participate at your own risk.



- * Timekeeping with chip is mandatory
- * All participants who might ski until darkness must have headlamp & batteries.
- * We recommend to have a mobile with you. Keep batteries warm!
- * You can quit the race at the checkpoints. Emergency service available at checkpoints.
- * Organizers have the right to stop participants if there is a health risk.
- * Be Covid19-aware, keep your distance!

- * Food: You get a snack bag & a 100 SEK food coupon valid in in Jokkmokk & Vuollerim.
- * Attention: The coupon is only valid for food and drinks, not for fuel.
- * We offer limited service at Västra skola: shower, coffee/tea and possibility to rest.

Bus transport to start



- * We offer free bus transport to the start from:
 - Vuollerim, Coop supermarket: 03:00
 - Arctic Camp: 03:15
 - Samelandsresor: between 03:15—04:15
- Some waiting time is possible. Be patient!

Clothing transport

- * All participants receive 3 bags for clothing. Black: Start; Grey: Randijaur; White: Sägduden. Mark your bag with the bigger labels with your start-id in the middle of the bag, press firmly. Seal with rubber bands.
- * We can not be held responsible for lost, damaged, or stolen bags or items. Do not put in anything sensible to freezing.
- * Black bags are available directly after the finish. Other bags are transported back to Jokkmokk little by little. You can pick them up on Sunday from 09:00 - 16:00.
- * We do not mail your bags home if you leave your bag behind.

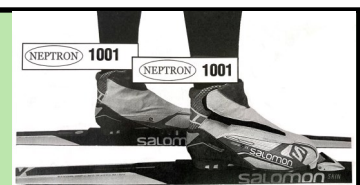
Waxing Service & spare poles

- * If you have booked extended waxing service by SkiGo: Leave your skis to SkiGo on Thursday 10.00 - 18.00 or Friday 8.00—20.00 at “Samelandsresor” .
- * A few extra poles are available at checkpoints which have to be returned after the race, otherwise we charge 500 SEK.

Distance:	200 kilometers (changed track due to weather conditions)
Technique:	Classic style
Start:	Purkijaur
Finish	Jokkmokk Ski Stadium
Pavva-Lasse medal:	For everyone who completes the distance under 21 hours and 22 minutes
Food:	Enervit sports drinks, tea, water, buns, cheese sandwiches, oranges, bananas, blueberry sup, Enervit energy bars and gel, Red Bull. In Randijaur (2x), Sågudden and Purkijaur we offer additional warm food; meat soup, pasta etc.
Starting time:	05:00
Competition rules:	FIS competition rules apply. Change of skis is not allowed except due to technical faults. Control of ski marking and pole length at the start. Seeding for elite skiers according to the following criteria: FIS points, Ski Classics overall ranking 2021/22 and results from Red Bull Nordenskiöld'sloppet 2016-2021.
Competition classes:	Total results and women / men separately. No senior classes.
Prizes:	1st prize, both male and female winners is SEK 50,000, 2nd place SEK 30,000, 3rd SEK 20,000. The Nordenskiöld Family Association donates a Challenge Trophy for best man and best woman.
